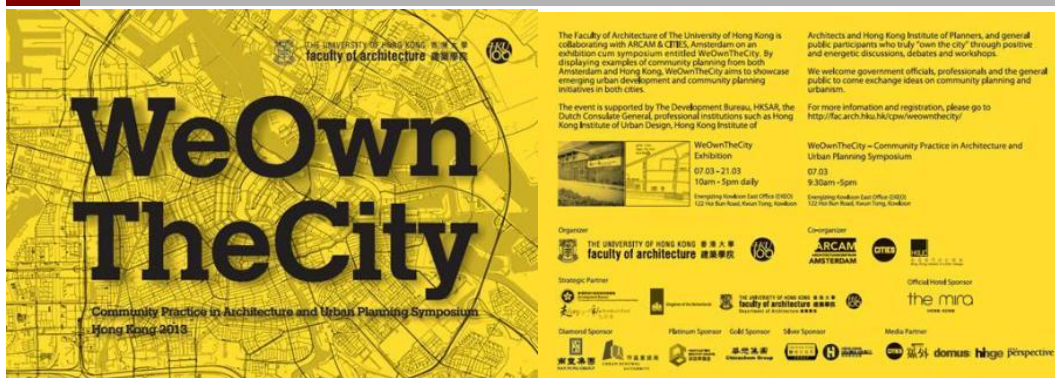

'Skyrise Greenery Awards 2012'

The Greening, Landscape and Tree Management Section (GLTMS) of the Development Bureau organised the 'Skyrise Greenery Awards 2012' with HKGBC, PGBC, HKIA, HKIE, HKILA, HKIP and HKIS. The Awards, being the first event of its kind in Hong Kong, aims to advocate skyrise greening in the building industry as an integral part of project design for a quality landscape and built environment, foster public appreciation of exemplary projects, and promote its wider adoption in Hong Kong.

The GLTMS has compiled information on the Awards and on the development of skyrise greening into a book called 'Skyrise Greenery Awards 2012' for promoting the development of the skyrise greening in Hong Kong and sharing with the general public.
