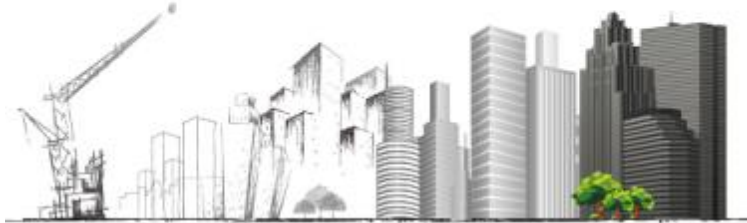

The AGM is being held at the Queens Café in the recently opened Comix Home Base in Wan Chai operated by the Hong Kong Arts Centre. The Comix Home Base is the first occupant of the URA's recently completed Mallory Street project which seeks to preserve and revitalise a cluster of ten pre-war tenements facing onto both Mallory Street and Burrows Street. The tiled pitched roof, balconies and timber features are just some of the many building attributes which have been preserved together with the introduction of a new public open space and an annex block to meet present day needs.

Mr. Michael Ma, Director of Planning & Design and Mr. Lawrence Mak, General Manager, Planning and Design at the URA will talk to the Institute and conduct a tour of the project.
