The main objective is to understand the public's aspiration towards the Victoria Harbourfront; whether the existing harbourfront development and management model could meet their aspiration; whether a dedicated Harbourfront Authority should be set up to bridge the gaps of the existing model; and if the public agrees that a Harbourfront Authority is required, which model is more suitable for Hong Kong.
