Abstract

The development of human civilization and culture was closely related to seas and major rivers. Hong Kong's topography is characterized by its water edges. 17 out of all 18 Districts in Hong Kong have waterfronts. Hong Kong has relied heavily on the world renowned Victoria Harbour in the past until the development of the mass transit railway system in recent decades. In recent years there are increasing calls in the community advocating the revitalization of our harbourfront by introducing cultural, recreational and business activities and capitalising on the opportunities brought by reintroduction of water borne transportation in the harbour. The Professional Green Building Council (PGBC), jointly with the Hong Kong Architecture Centre (HKAC), Hong Kong Institute of Urban Design (HKIUD) and the Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport (CILT), will visit the potentials and constraints of actively introducing harbourfront activities and water borne transportation in Hong Kong, for betterment of feasibility and positioning of Hong Kong as a world class city.
