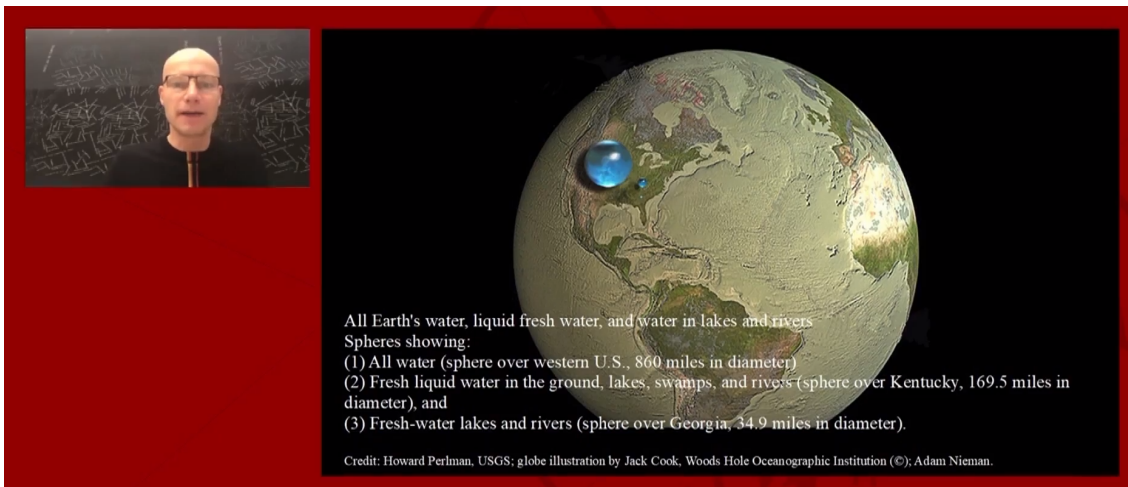

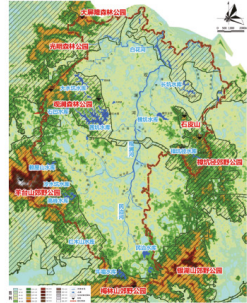
01 龙华环城绿道——连接人与自然

Greenway of Longhua Ringroad- Make connection between human and nature

在城市快速发展的时代，高密度聚集的都市，深圳龙华区，城市内部缺乏足够的绿色开放空间，而现有外围的生态郊野地区，又多处于封闭和不友好的状态。项目通过生态修复和绿道建设，将位于边缘地区的57平方公里郊野绿地串联起来，为市民提供更多的城市公共活动空间，激发了片区的发展活力。

In the era of rapid urban development, high-density Longhua District in Shenzhen city which lacks enough green open space inside the city, and most of the existing peripheral ecological countryside areas are closed and unfriendly. Through ecological restoration and greenway construction, the project connects 57 square kilometers of rural green space located at the edge of the area, providing more urban public activity space for the public and stimulating the development vitality of the area.

项目背景 Project background



龙华区具有典型的低山丘陵地貌特征，三面环山，一水贯城。生态控制线面积约占全区总面积37%，集中分布在城区四周，内部绿地稀少。Longhua district has typical landform features of low mountains and hills, surrounded by mountains on three sides and penetrated by water. The area of ecological control line accounts for 37% of the total area of the whole district, which is concentrated around the urban area, and the internal green space is scarce.



深圳市人均公共绿地面积: 16.8M²
龙华区人均绿地面积: 15.4M²
龙华区城区人均公园绿地: 3.3M²

由于地处原特区外，缺乏有序规划和建设，城市内部绿地和公共空间有限，又面临地价高企和高密度的人口，市民亲近自然和休闲游憩的需求长期得不到满足。Due to the lack of orderly planning and construction outside the original special zone, the limited green space and public space inside the city, and the high land price and high density of population, the citizens' demand for access to nature and recreation area to leisure has not been met for a long time.

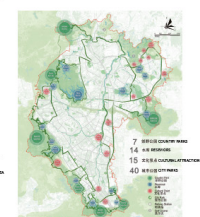


由于城市边缘地带发展相对滞后，公共交通不发达，这些生态绿地虽然被定性为郊野公园，但可达性差，利用率低，部分地段甚至成了违建屡禁不止、环境脏乱差的灰色地带。Due to the relatively backward development of urban fringe areas and underdeveloped public transport, although these ecological green spaces are classified as country parks, they have poor accessibility and low utilization rate, and some areas even become grey areas with illegal construction and dirty environment.

三大策略 Three strategies



策略一：修复
通过生态因子评价和分析，对碎片化和受损的生态斑块进行了生态修复，并转化为自然野趣的优美景观。
Through the evaluation and analysis of ecological factors, ecological restoration was carried out on the broken and damaged ecological patch, and the patch was transformed into a beautiful landscape of natural wild interest.

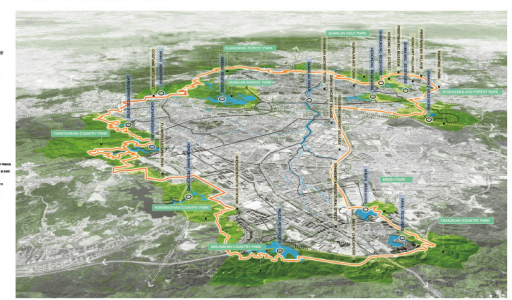


策略二：链接
172公里的绿道串联了7个郊野公园，14个大水塘湖泊，15个景区，40处城市公园，形成一条环绕全城的连续活力风廊。
The 172km greenway links 7 country parks, 14 reservoirs and lakes, 15 scenic spots and 40 urban parks, forms a continuous dynamic landscape belt around the city.



策略三：激活
75公里的主线组成的大环，以及97公里星形分支形成的20个节点，将人、城市与自然连接在一起，为市民提供多样的活动场所，满足不同时间不同年龄的需求，激活了边缘地区的活力。
The large ring formed by the main line of 75 km and 20 small rings formed by the branch line of 97 km which connect people, city and nature together, provide diverse activities for citizens, meet the needs of different times and different ages, and stimulate the vitality of the marginal urban area.

Locally balanced earthwork by design served to create space of lake and island with excavation and embankment. The characteristic spatial layout integrates the water landscape into the urban view, allowing the island to complement urban space.

The water system is built as a diverse ecological landscape. Shorelines are designed with natural gentle slopes. Local wetland plants are selected for environment restoration while creating a wetland landscape.

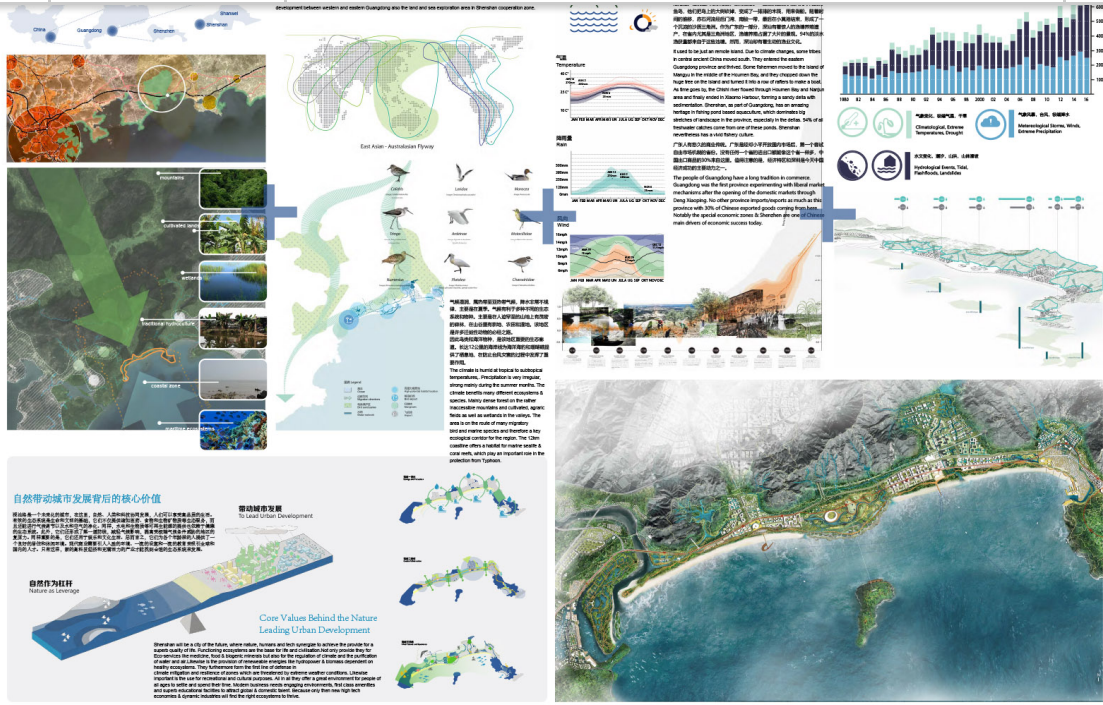

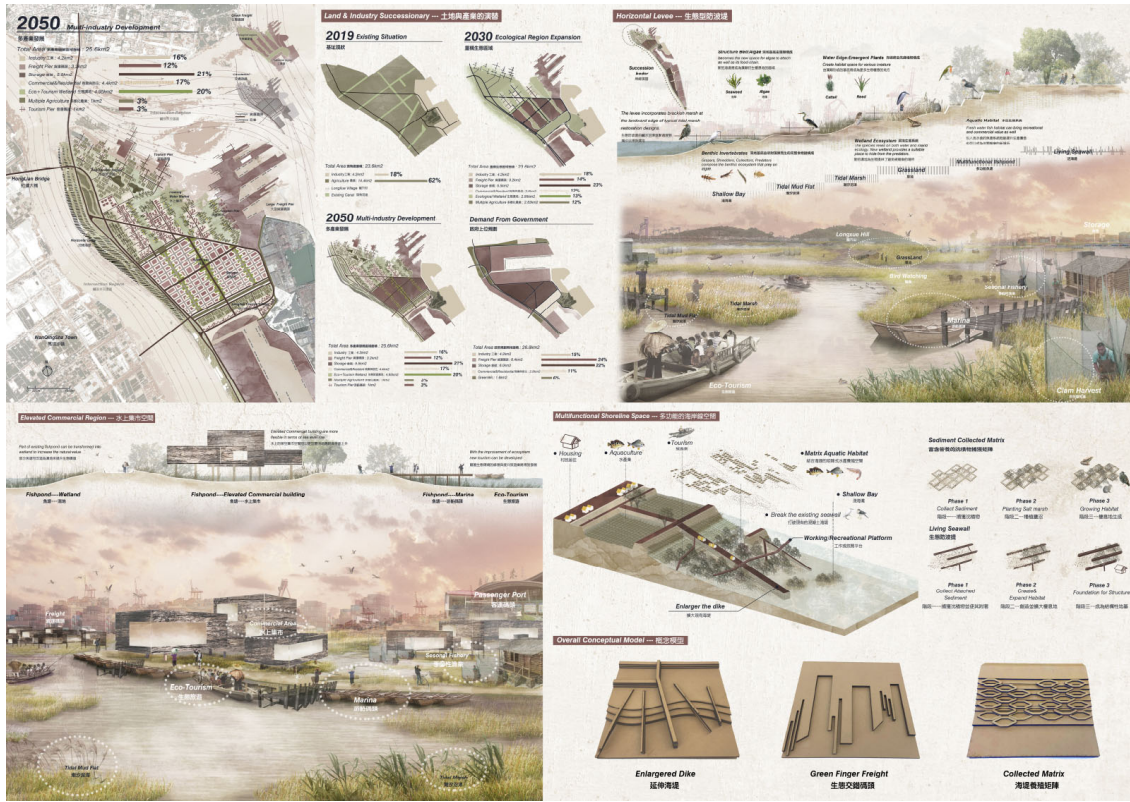

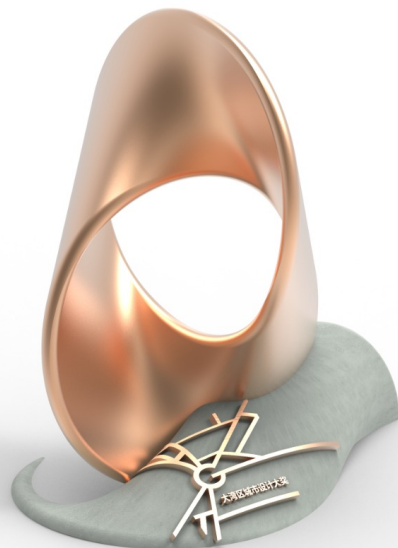




Alluvial Shoreline-The Retrofit of Sediment Action Between Industry and Fishery

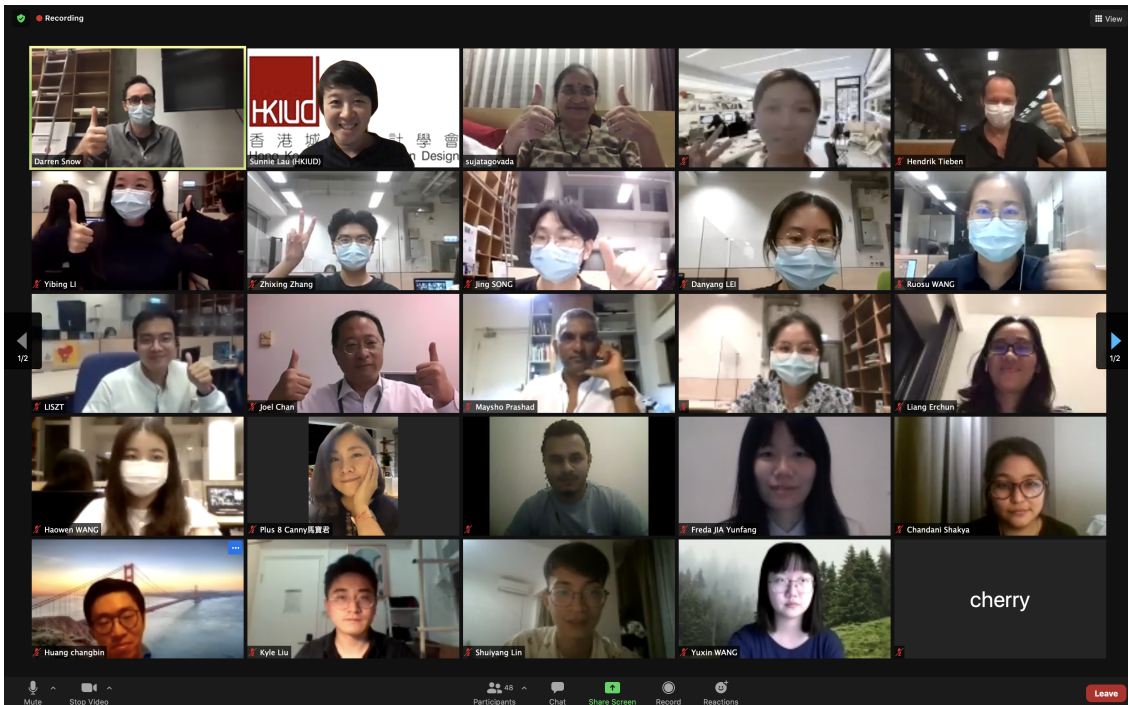
