HKIUD Urban Design Conference 2018 - Inclusive Urban Design for Active Ageing



We are all aware of the global trend of rapid ageing. The World Health Organization has listed various factors for cities to adapt accordingly. Many cities are engaging in efforts such as improving elderly services, healthcare and universal accessibility. However, not much substantial research or work has been done in terms of urban design for enhancing aged people's active lifestyle through improving the elderly's sense of safety and comfort in going out (e.g. through access to seating and toilets), adequate time for crossing roads, finding places for meeting people of diverse ages, and more.

The conference aims to explore principles and successful examples of inclusive urban design for active ageing. More importantly, the conference aims to reveal tangible, specific solutions and methods for addressing these issues in Hong Kong from both a "hardware" (structure, public space, connectivity, etc.) and "software" (social engagement, healthcare, policy, etc.) perspective. At the end of the conference, HKIUD aims to consolidate conference findings with takeaways from other HKIUD research initiatives, then publicize them for the benefit of wider society.

The conference is scheduled on **22 June 2018**. International speakers from the region and around the world will share experiences from their cities, and local experts will respond and discuss local urban design and ageing population issues.

To ensure the event's success and continued organization in future, we are looking for generous sponsors who believe in the importance of improving our city's liveability over the long-term while maintaining social harmony. We are now inviting both international and local speakers.
