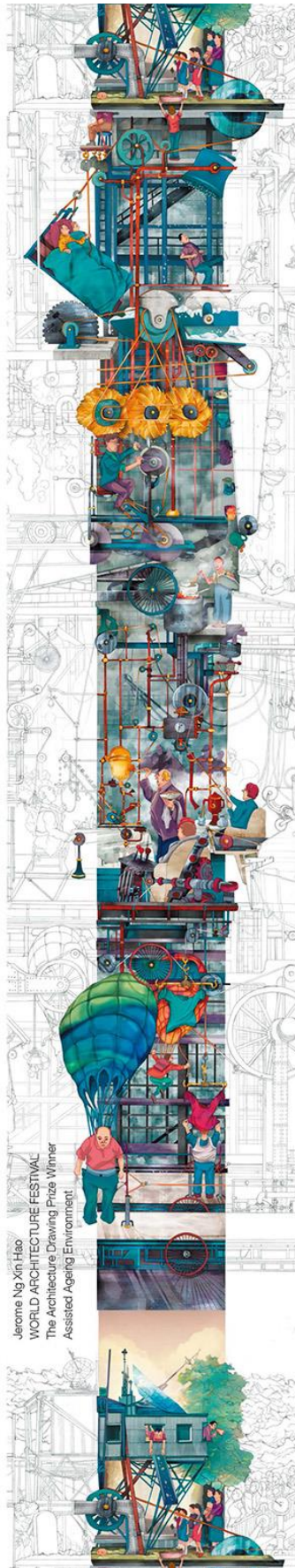

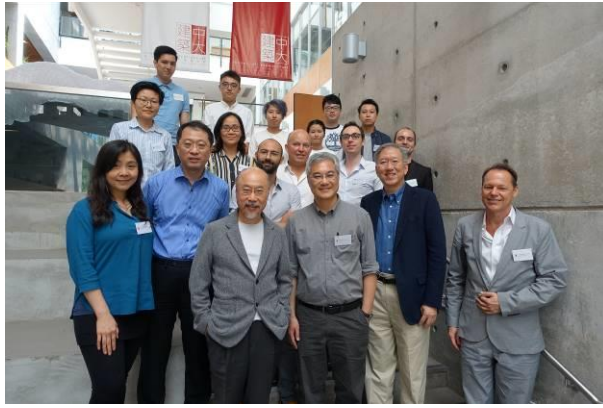

DESIGN THINKING WORKSHOP FOR URBANISM AND CITY BUILDING

What is it?

This two-part workshop explores design thinking methods and how they apply to urbanism, planning and design. Design thinking introduces a human-centric context to urbanism. They are increasingly being used to create spaces that deeply resonate with communities and position them to better address complex urban challenges.

Join designer & urban planner Howard Tam from Canada's ThinkFresh Group to learn the method, techniques and tools to decipher the human context in cities. This workshop is being offered in two parts over 2 Saturdays in June.

Workshop A: Introduction to Design Thinking Methods and Mindset (June 23 2018)

This is a basic 101 workshop to introduce design thinking methods, empathy and the mindset. The workshop will run through a simple design problem and get participants thinking about how this applies in their own context. No previous experience required.

Workshop B: Design Thinking in Urban Planning & Design: A Human Experience & Strategic Approach (June 30 2018)

This workshop will take an 'Urban Working' as the design design into human-centric research methods and exploration. New design tools will be used to meet the challenges of urban planning and design. The workshop will cover research methods, synthesizing insights, and understanding how to create impactful human strategies for urban spaces. Previous attendance at the Workshop A is preferred but not required.
