In the past few months after the last AGM in September, the Office Bearers and Council members worked closely together with various new and old committee members. Targets and objectives were mapped out for the coming 2 years Council term. To name a few of the ongoing efforts working in progress, the Membership and Accreditation Committee is compiling a registered list of Urban Design Practices for Hong Kong; the Public Affairs Committee is organizing regular gatherings with the press media; the Research and Education Committee is formulating the Urban Design Compendium for Hong Kong, which will be a big step forward towards an Urban Design Principles/Protocols for Hong Kong; the newly formed International and Mainland Affairs Committee is exploring connections with overseas and organisations in Mainland, to establish a global network for Urban Designers and Urbanists. Last but not least, with joint effort of HKU and CUHK, the Young Members Committee is conducting various office visits to major Urban Design Practices to reinforce the linkage between the academic sector and the industry. More activities for the younger Urban Designers, students and graduates are in the pipeline.

Collaborations with other major professional institutes will be continued as in the last Council term. For example, the seminar: "Urban Design Creates Value – Place Making from New York to Hong Kong" on 29 January mentioned in this newsletter is a co-organised event with the Professional Green Building Council for promoting Urban Design. The Council will continue to uphold our professional views for the betterment of our city.

James Corner is the Founding Principal and CEO of James Corner Field Operations, an international landscape architectural and urban design studio based in New York City, San Francisco, London and Shenzhen. He has devoted the past 20 years to advancing the field of urbanism, primarily through his leadership on high-visibility, complex urban projects at Field Operations, as well as through teaching, public speaking and writing. Important public realm design projects include New York's highly-acclaimed High Line, London's South Park at Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park, Santa Monica's Tongva Park, Chicago's Navy Pier, Cleveland's Public Square, Philadelphia's Race Street Pier, Hong Kong's Salisbury Gardens and Avenue of Stars, and Shenzhen's new city of Qianhai.

James led the design for the new Salisbury Garden and the Avenue of Stars. His years-long efforts to deliver a tailored response to Hong Kong was culminated by the completion of the Salisbury Garden in December 2017, which has won numerous design awards as well as accolades from its users and stakeholders. The Avenue of Stars will reopen in late January 2019 and it will not only continue being world class destination but it will bring together public, leisure and educational activities that will form a richly interconnected mix of urban life this time.

James's work also has been recognized with the National Design Award, the American Academy of Arts and Letters Award in Architecture, the Daimler Chrysler Design Excellence Award, and the AIAA Black Pencil Award. His work has been published broadly and exhibited at the New York Museum of Modern Art, the Cooper Hewitt Design Museum, the National Building Museum, the Royal Academy of Art in London, and the Venice Biennale. His books include The High Line (Princeton, 2015), The Landscape Integration (Princeton, 2014), and Taking Measures Across the American Landscape (Yale, 1998).

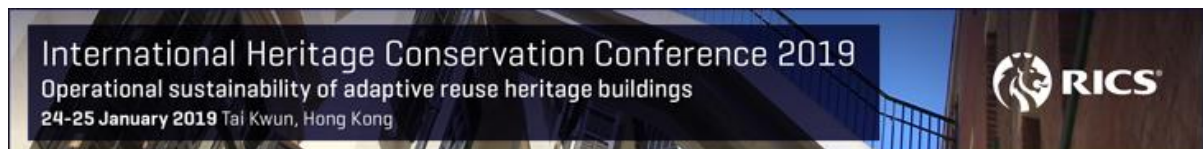

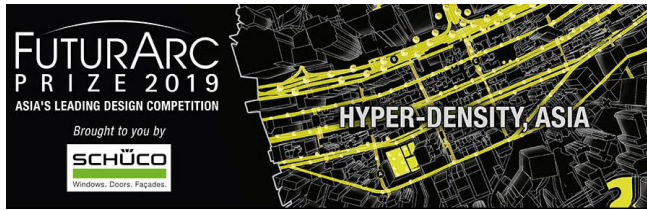
